About Seminar

Cerebral Palsy (CP) is the most common physical disability in childhood. Despite recent advances in neonatal management and obstetric care, there is no decline in its incidence. Moreover, the decline in infant mortality rate has actually increased CP incidence. In context of Nepal, CP still remains a highly stigmatizing condition with families lacking access to basic information and support and many children receiving ineffective therapies. The assessment and management of CP requires a multidisciplinary approach with a team of professionals from various specialties. We have many children of CP presenting with complications like seizures, aspiration pneumonitis, hearing/vision problems, contractures, etc.. Hence this seminar will serve as a platform where all the stakeholders involved in management of CP, including involved doctors from various departments, physiotherapists, parents/guardians/caretakers and special educators come and share their ideas for providing better care.
